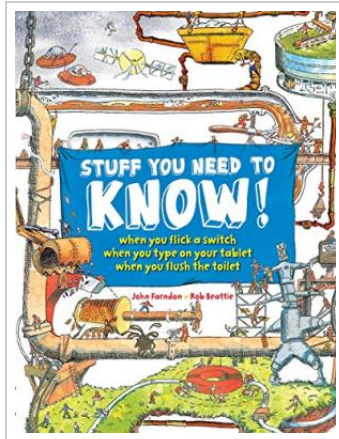




Stuff You Need to Know!
