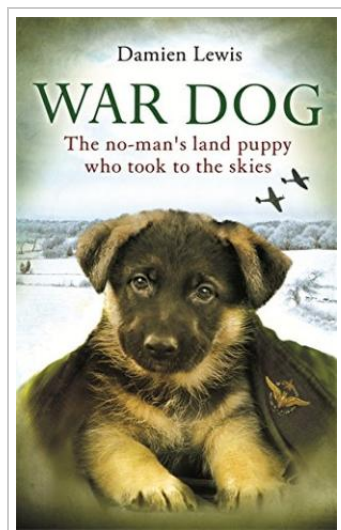




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War Dog: The no-man s-land puppy who took to the skies (Paperback)
