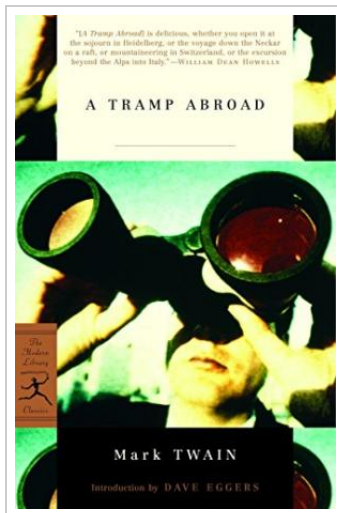




A Mod Lib Tramp Abroad, A (Paperback)
