GAO found that the conference committee for the Department of Defense (DOD) fiscal year 1984 appropriations act directed the Air Force to plan for transferring 36 C-141 aircraft to ARF. The Air Force recommended transferring C-5, as well as C-141 aircraft, to ARF because of the higher operational costs of the C-5 and the large peacetime role of the C-141 aircraft. GAO believes that ARF bases receiving new aircraft must acquire sufficient spare parts to preclude excessive grounding of aircraft; however, excessive spares will increase costs of storage and transportation and result in unnecessary or premature acquisitions. GAO found that the Air Force planned to establish a jet engine intermediate maintenance facility at Kelly Air Force Base (AFB) as part of the transfer of C-5 aircraft to three ARF units.
