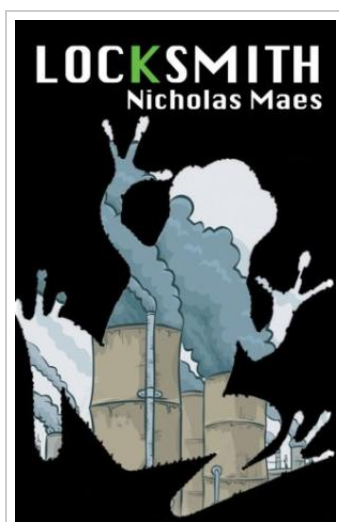




Locksmith: A Felix Taylor Adventure (Paperback)
