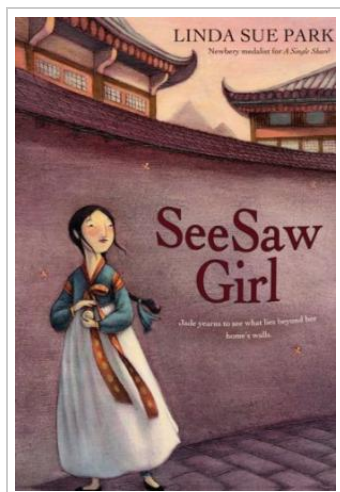




Seesaw Girl (Paperback)
