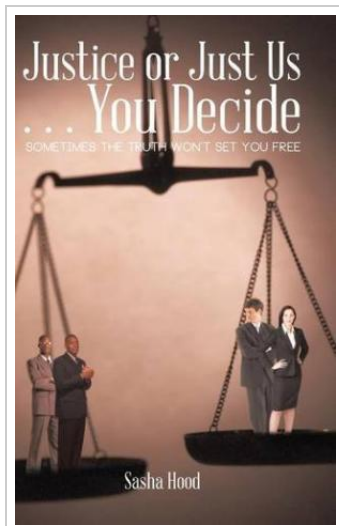




Justice or Just Us . . . You Decide: Sometimes the Truth Won't Set You Free
