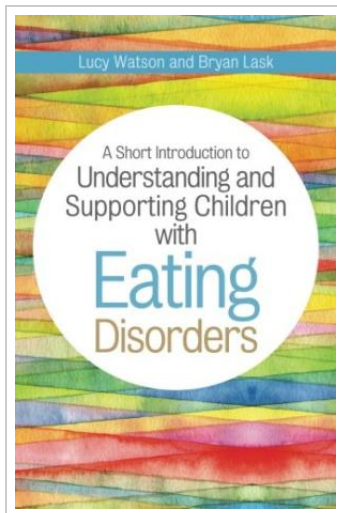




## A Short Introduction to Understanding and Supporting Children with Eating Disorders (Paperback)
