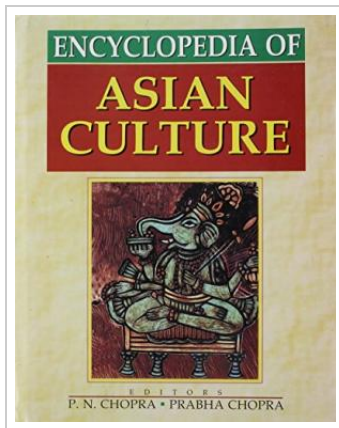




Encyclopedia of Asian Culture
