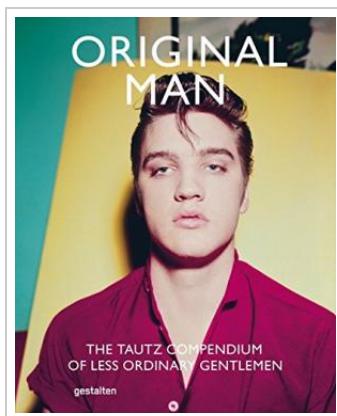




Original Man
