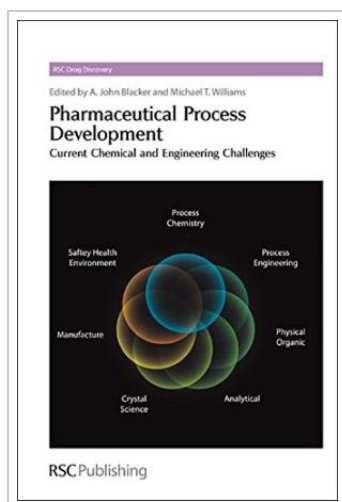




Pharmaceutical Process Development: Current Chemical and Engineering Challenges (Hardback)

The book ends with an assessment of future trends and challenges.
