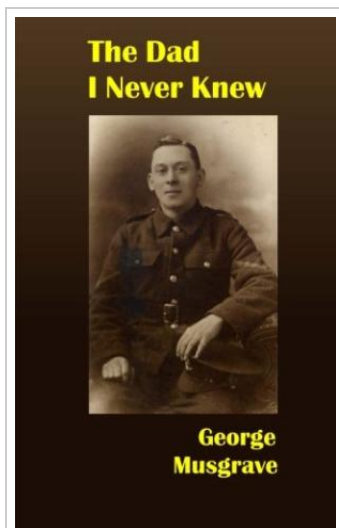




The Dad I Never Knew (Paperback)
