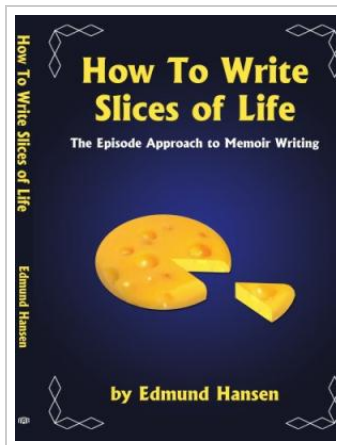




How To Write Slices of Life: The Episode Approach to Memoir Writing
