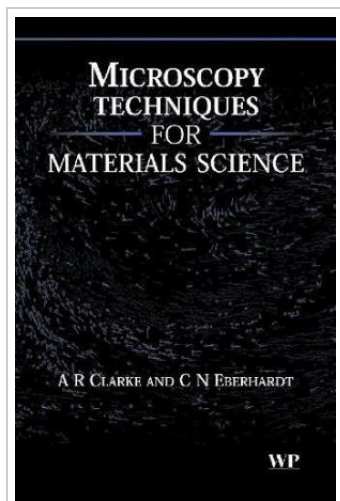




Microscopy Techniques for Materials Science (Hardback)
