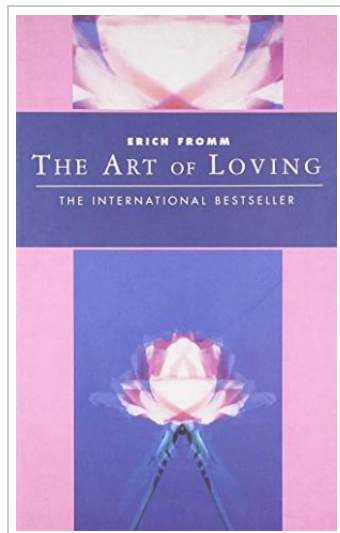




The Art of Loving (Paperback)
