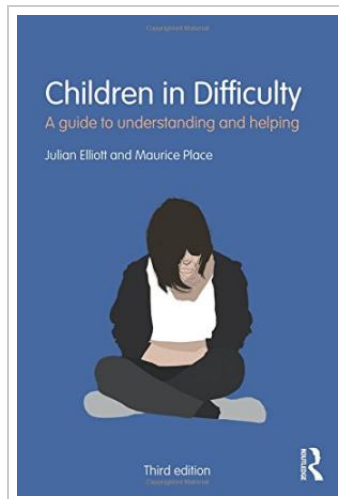




Children in Difficulty: A guide to understanding and helping (Paperback)
