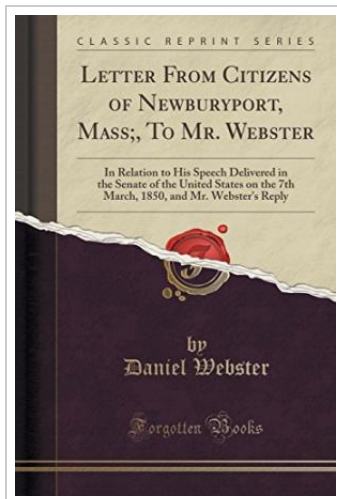

Brand New Book ***** Print on Demand *****.Excerpt from Letter From Citizens of Newburyport, Mass,, To Mr. Webster: In Relation to His Speech Delivered in the Senate of the United States on the 7th March, 1850, and Mr. Webster s Reply The Constitution of the United States, in the 2d section of the 4th article, declares: A person charged in any State with treason, felony, or other crime, who shall flee from justice, and be found in another State, shall, en demand of this executive authority of the State from which he fled, be delivered up, to be removed to the State having jurisdiction of the crime. No person held to service or labor in one State, under the laws thereof, escaping into another, shall, in consequence of any law or regulation therein, be discharged from such service or labor, but shall be delivered up on claim of the party to whom such service or labor may be due. This provision of the Constitution seems to have met with little exception or opposition, or none at all, so far as I know, in Massachusetts....



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
