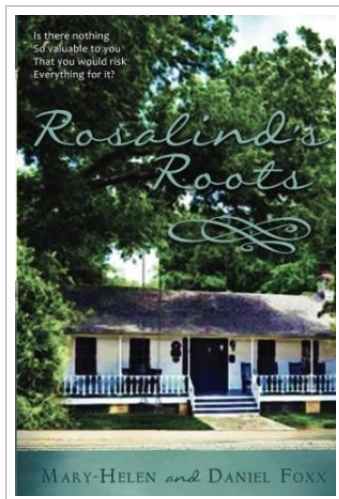




Rosalind s Roots (Paperback)
