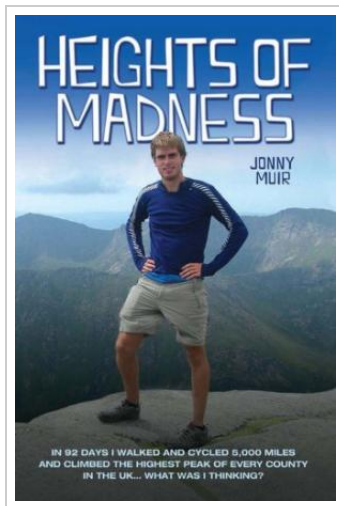




Heights of Madness (Paperback)
