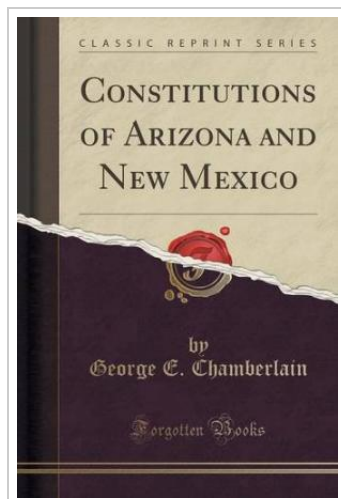

Res. 2) approving the constitutions formed by the constitutional conventions of the Territory of New Mexico and the Territory of Arizona - Mr. CHAMBERLAIN said: Mr. President: The Sixty-first Congress passed an act entitled An act to enable the people of New Mexico to form a constitution and State government and be admitted to the Union on an equal footing with the original States, and to enable the people of Arizona to form a constitution and State government and be admitted to the Union on an equal footing with the original States. This act was approved by the President on the 20th day of June, 1910. On the 21st day of January, 1911, the people of New Mexico adopted a constitution, and on the 7th day of February, 1911. the people of Arizona adopted theirs. An effort was made in the expiring moments of the last Congress to adopt House joint resolution 295, approving the constitution of New Mexico, and...
