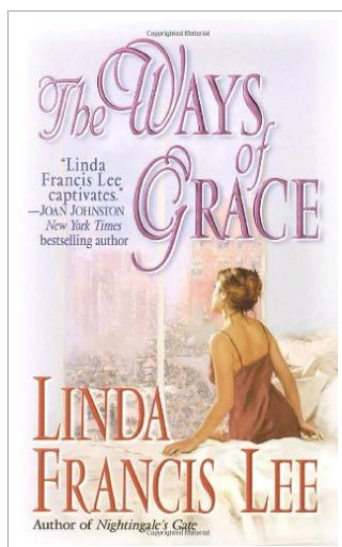




The Ways of Grace
