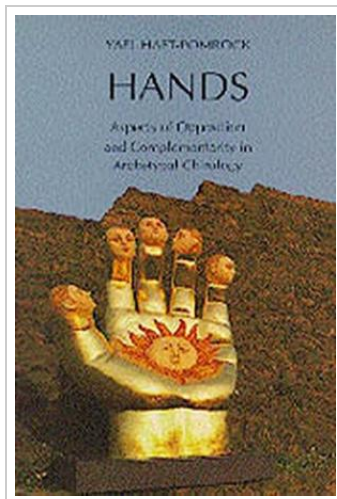




Hands : Aspects of Opposition and complementarity in Archetypal Chirolgy
