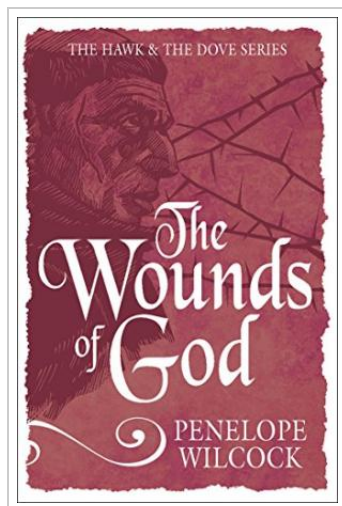




The Wounds of God (Paperback)
