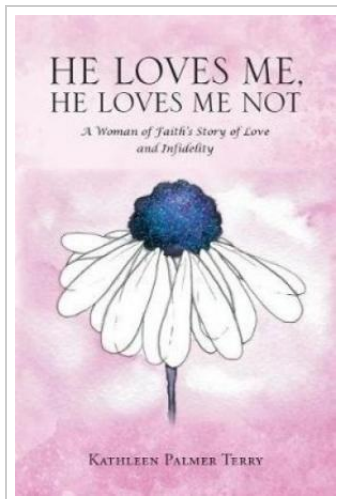




He Loves Me, He Loves Me Not: A Woman of Faith s Story of Love and Infidelity (Paperback)
