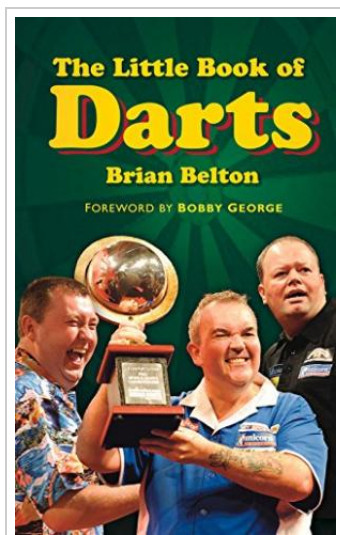




The Little Book of Darts
