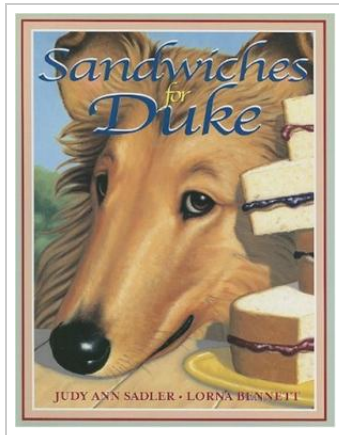




Sandwiches for Duke (Paperback)
