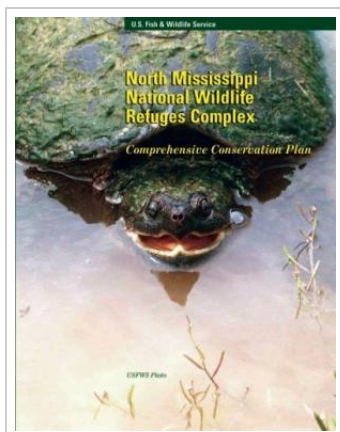




North Mississippi National Wildlife Refuge Complex: Comprehensive Conservation Plan
