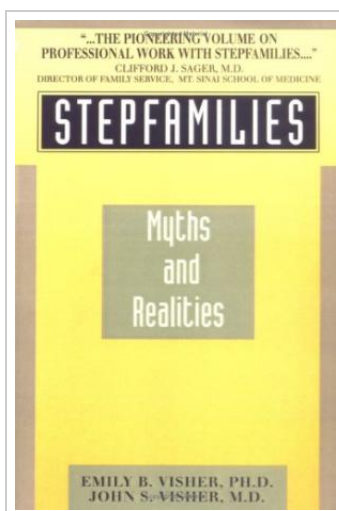




Stepfamilies: Myths and Realities
