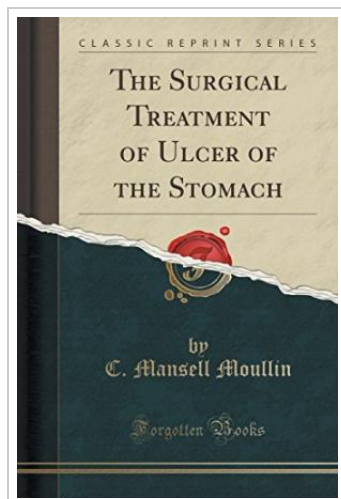

Excerpt from The Surgical Treatment of Ulcer of the Stomach The reason of this discrepancy is simply that the condition of the mucous membrane of the stomach during life, especially when it is in amed, is absolutely different from what it is after death. During life, and especially while digestion is going on, the mucous mem brane is exceedingly well supplied with blood. It is soft, bright red, thick, and full of uid. After death it is thin, bloodless, accid, and in colour a pale slaty gray - it hardly looks like the same structure, the difference is so great; and in cases of acute ulceration, owing to the in ammatory changes in the surrounding tissues, the difference is greater still. Immediately around the ulcer the mucous membrane is swollen, con gested and raised above the level of the rest. Its colour is bright red, though the interior of the stomach may be paler than natural from loss of blood. Here and there I have seen the surface dotted with little blood-stained points from vessels that have given way. The sides...
