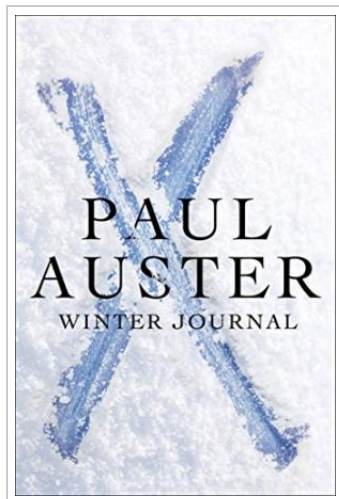




Winter Journal
