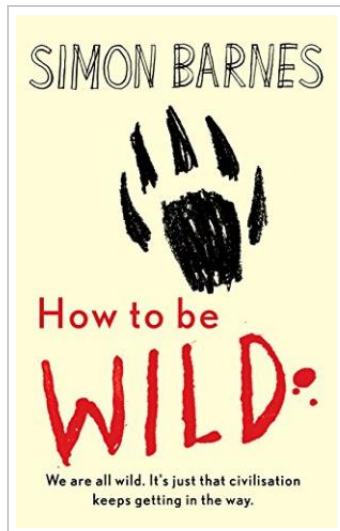




How to be Wild (Hardback)
