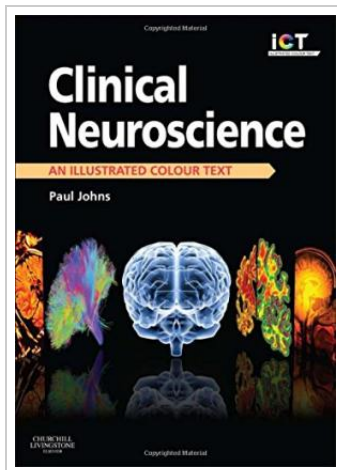




Clinical Neuroscience: An Illustrated Colour Text (Paperback)

The first part of the book deals with fundamental areas of neuroscience required for a sound understanding of brain disease. This is followed by an account of the neurobiology of the most common and important brain diseases of the western world (stroke, epilepsy, Alzheimer s disease, Parkinson s disease and multiple sclerosis). The book is in the same general style as the successful Crossman: Neuroanatomy with extensive colour illustrations. Short, affordable and readable introductory level text in the same style as Crossman: Neuroanatomy. Assumes little previous neuroscience knowledge. Explains fundamental concepts without overwhelming detail. Focuses on clinically relevant material. Includes the most common and important neurological disorders.
