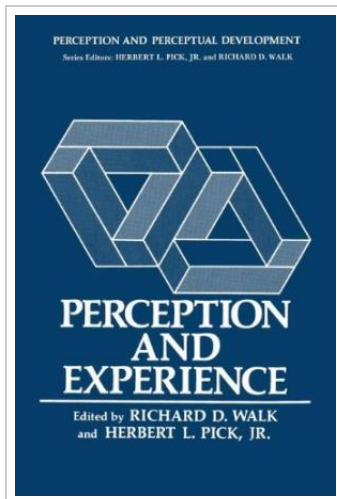




Perception and Experience

In recent years, significant, indeed dramatic, advances have occurred in the study of perception.
