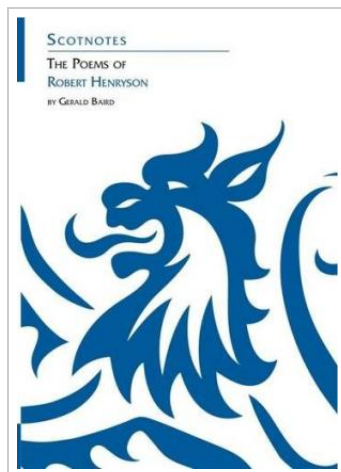




The Poems of Robert Henryson
