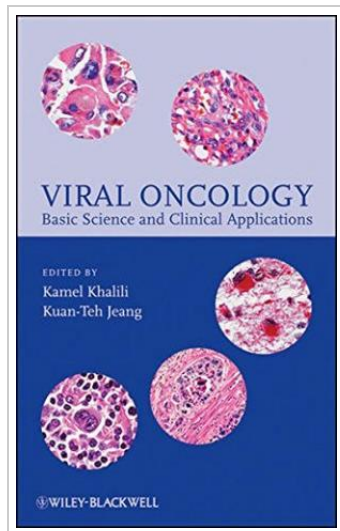




Viral Oncology: Basic Science and Clinical Applications (Hardback)
