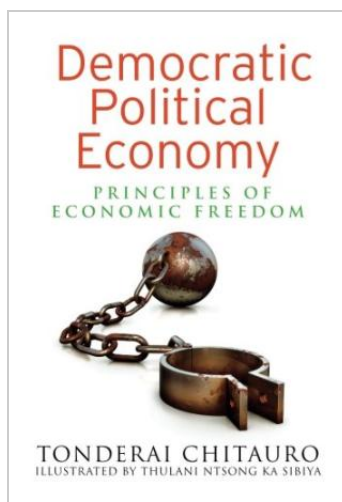




Democratic Political Economy: Principles of Economic Freedom
