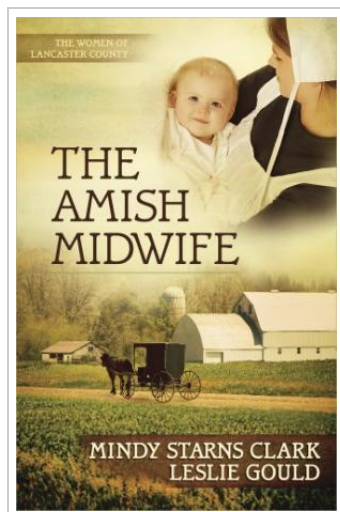




The Amish Midwife (Paperback)
