Though this book's main challenge is to define the theology of social justice with the eschatological perspective of Christians in Okinawa during the U.S. administration of Okinawa (1945-1972), this book also introduces the mission work of God done by Christians in Okinawa in an extreme situation, in a period when the people who were socially vulnerable had been placed at the periphery of society. In this fine study, Dr. Mikio reveals a little-known story of collaboration between a few missionaries and Japanese Christians to address human rights abuses perpetuated in Okinawa by the United States during the Cold War. Although results were limited, and heroes were few, this case study illustrates why cross-cultural partnership and prophetic witness remain essential to missional faithfulness.
