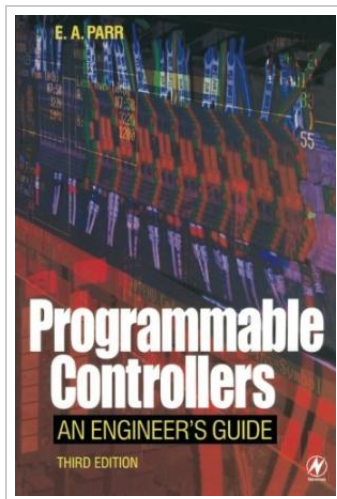




Programmable Controllers: An Engineer's Guide
