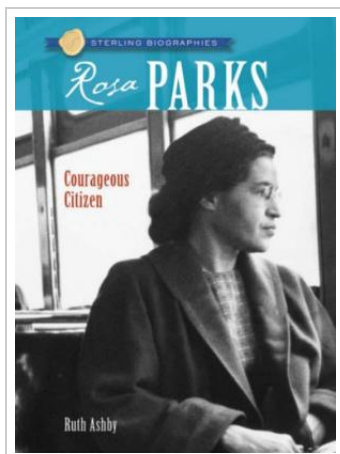




Rosa Parks: Courageous Citizen
