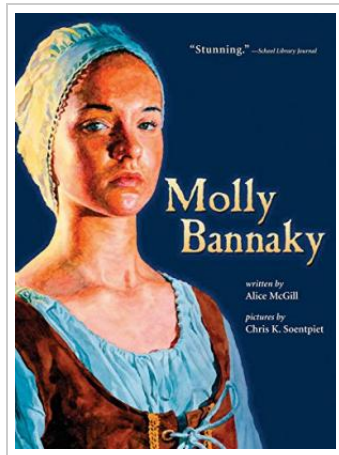




Molly Bannaky (Paperback)
