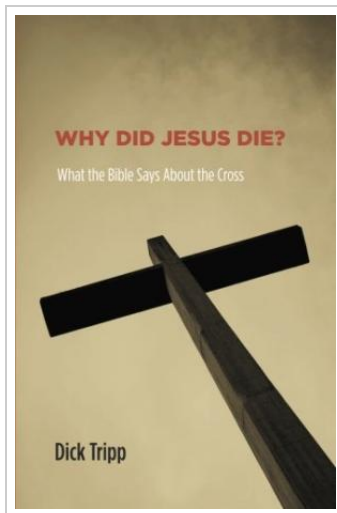




Why Did Jesus Die?: What the Bible Says about the Cross
