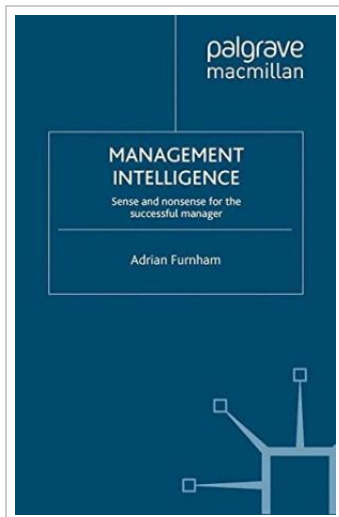




Management Intelligence: Sense and Nonsense for the Successful Manager
