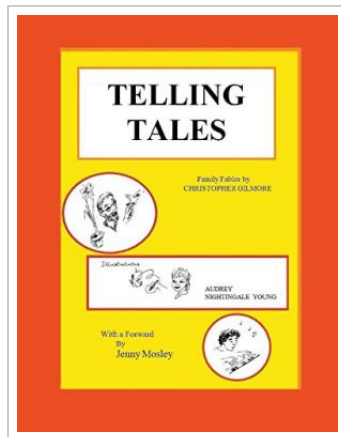




Telling Tales

He is certainly versatile - an actor, writer, teacher and dramatist, he has had more than 20 plays and musicals staged, including Telling Tales as a school musical adapted and directed by the author and pronounced in the Reading Chronicle as a show full of Magic Moments !...
