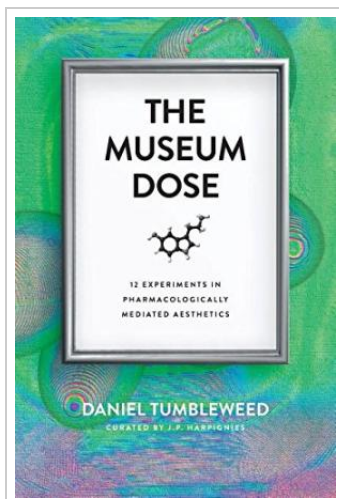




The Museum Dose: 12 Experiments in Pharmacologically Mediated Aesthetics
