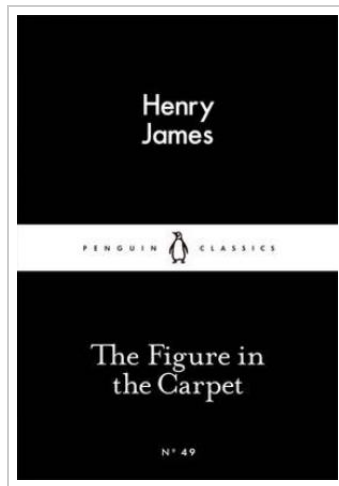




The Figure in the Carpet
