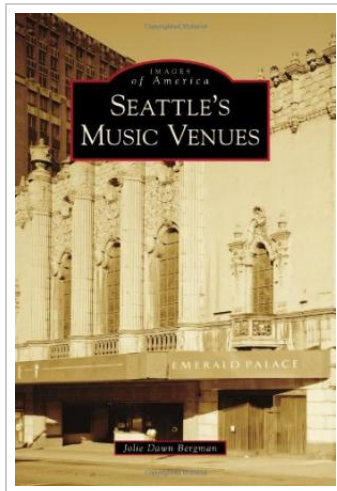




Seattle's Music Venues (Paperback)
