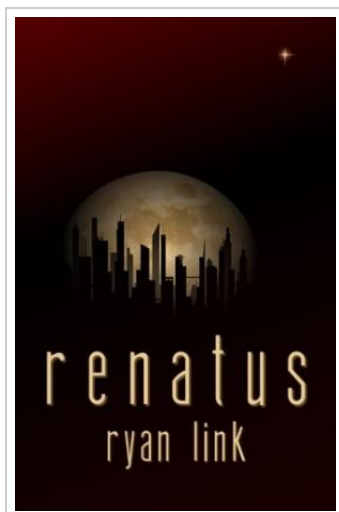




renatus
