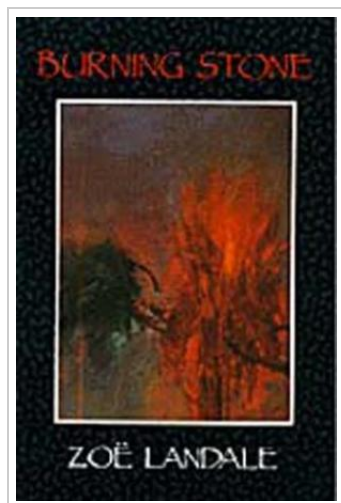




Burning Stone

Book Description In her third book, Zo Landale explores the darkened rooms of family myth and history. Focussing on family members from the past-matrons, suicides and brilliant eccentrics-she investigates their lives and the shadowy but potent power they exert over the present. Discovering at first only bitterness and anger, Landale pushes further to see these ghostly figures in the light of their own aspirations. Especially powerful is the description of the earlier women of Landale's family-strong yet struggling to find their own voices. Burning Stone enacts a journey into the light, the generation of understanding and forgiveness within the family.



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
