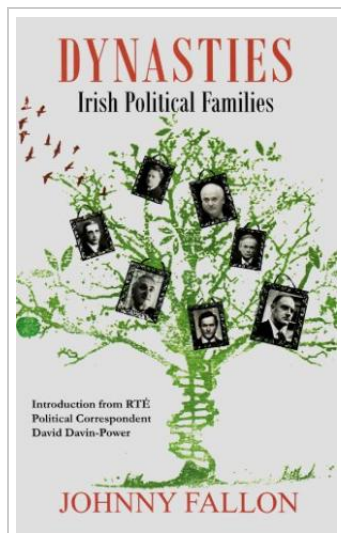




Dynasties: Irish Political Families
